in open Court in the County off Chard the Seaventeenth day of March One  
Thousand Six hundred Sixty Two by the said Humphrey together with  
Elizabeth his wife assigned to Thomas Peirry the like said Thomas  
Peirry upon the moneth fifteth day of November one thousand six hundred  
Sixty two for the Consideration of four thousand pounds of tobacco to  
him paid by Thomas Carrile agreed to assigne the promissed to deli-  
ver him the Patten aforesaid in Court together with eliz. & Petowry  
to be acknowledged in Court by the said Thomas Peirry & Humphrey & wife  
the wife which was accordingly done by the said Humphrey & his wife and  
the said Thomas Peirry upon the said Seaventeenth day of March 1662.  
And the same day the said Thomas Carrile did in open Court in the County  
aforesaid Assign all his Right Title & Interest of the said Patten unto  
John Legatt of the same County Clerk shortly after to witt on the  
seaventeenth day of March in the yeare of our Lord One Thousand Six-  
hundred Sixty Three he the said John Legatt dyed. And the said  
Juryors upon thair Oath further say that they doo not know that the  
said John Legatt had any issue of his body lawfully begotten or left  
any heires. But they say that the said John Legatt dyed before any  
part of the Consideration for the payment of the said lands was paid to  
the said Thomas Carrile. That after the death of the said John Legatt  
the said Thomas Carrile did upon the fourteenth day of March One  
Thousand Six hundred Sixty Five in Consideration of four thousand four  
hundred pounds of tobacco paid to Mrs Bridget Legatt the Widow & Relat  
of the said John Legatt assigne the promissed to her & her heires for  
ever that she the said Bridget Legatt heire ever since held & occupied  
the same & paid the Rent to the Lord Proprietary due for the same & hath  
been at great Charge in building upon the same & clearing and  
improving the same & that the said lands are worth by the yeare  
as the same is now improved four hundred pounds of tobacco In  
testimony whereof after the said Commissiones and the said Juryors to this  
Exquisition have severallagably set thair hands & sealed the day  
thereof above said.
