 Sixty two for the Consideration of four thousand pounds of Tobacco to
 him paid by Thomas Carville agreed to Assigne the premises to deli-
 ver him the Patent aforesaid in Court together with A Fine & Recovery
 to be Acknowledged in Court by the said Thomas Pirry & Humphrey Mricks
 & his wife which was accordingly done by the said Humphrey & his wife and
 the said Thomas Pirry upon the said seventeenth day of March 1662
 And the same day the said Thomas Carville did in open Court in the County
 aforesaid Assigne all his Right Title & Interest of the said Patent unto
 John Legatt of the same County Clerk & shortly after to wit on the
 seventeenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand six
 hundred Sixty three to the said John Legatt Dyed: And the said
 Jurors upon their Oathes further say that they do not know that the
 said John Legatt had any Issue of his body lawfully begotten or left
 any heires But they say that the said John Legatt Dyed before any
 part of the Consideration for the purchase of the said lands was paid to
 the said Thomas Carville that after the death of the said John Legatt
 the said Thomas Carville did upon the fourteenth day of March One
 thousand six hundred Sixty three in Consideration of four thousand four
 hundred pounds of Tobacco paid by Mrs Bridget Legatt the Widow & Heire
 of the said John Legatt Assigne the premises to her & her heires for
 ever that she the said Bridget Legatt heath ever since had occupied
 the same & paid the Rent to the Lord Proprietor due for the same & hath
 bene at great Charges in building upon the same & clearing and
 improving the same that the said lands are worth by the yeare
 at the same is now improved four hundred pounds of Tobacco In
 testimony whereof aswell the said Comissioners as the said Jurors to this
 Inquisition have Authoritatively set their hands & Seales the day
 & yeare aforesaid
