- (ii) Part-time nurse at the rate of [2 years] ONE-HALF YEAR for each year that the recipient performs the service obligation.
- (2) The repayment of the grant award by a recipient who is not yet required by the provisions of this subtitle to begin repayment of the grant award and who accepts employment that fulfills the service obligation shall be forgiven, for the purposes of this subtitle, for a:
- (i) Full-time nurse at the rate of 1 year for each year that the recipient performs the service obligation; or
- (ii) Part-time nurse at the rate of [2 years] ONE-HALF YEAR for each year that the recipient performs the service obligation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
