- (3) A medical laboratory shall pay the Department a fee established by the Secretary to cover the cost of the laboratory's State cytology proficiency testing program under this section.
- (4) The Secretary shall adopt regulations for the cytology proficiency testing program that:
- (i) Define satisfactory cytology proficiency testing performance; and
- (ii) Set standards and requirements that a cytology proficiency testing program must meet before it can be designated an approved program.
- (5) The Secretary may accept the testing results of an approved cytology proficiency testing program as meeting the cytology proficiency testing requirement of this subtitle.

## 19-308.

- (a) The Secretary shall adopt reasonable rules and regulations that set standards of services for related institutions, <u>ACCREDITED HOSPITALS</u>, nonaccredited hospitals, <u>ACCREDITED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTERS</u>, and nonaccredited residential treatment centers in the following areas:
  - (1) The care of patients;
  - (2) The medical supervision of patients;
  - (3) The physical environment;
  - (4) Disease control:
  - (5) Sanitation;
  - (6) Safety; and
  - (7) Dietary matters.
- (b) (1) To assure compliance with the standards adopted under this subtitle, the Secretary shall have an inspection made:
- (i) Of each related institution, each ACCREDITED HOSPITAL OR nonaccredited hospital, and each ACCREDITED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER OR nonaccredited residential treatment center for which a license is sought; and
- (ii) Periodically of each related institution, each ACCREDITED HOSPITAL OR nonaccredited hospital, and each ACCREDITED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER OR nonaccredited residential treatment center for which a license has been issued.
- [(2) An accredited hospital and an accredited residential treatment center shall be subject to inspections under this subtitle by the Department to:
- (i) Investigate a complaint in accordance with § 19-309 of this part;
