## Section 6-117

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

6-117.

~~(A) THERE IS A THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT PROGRAMS FOR NEW TEACHERS EMPLOYED BY HARD-TO-STAFF SCHOOLS, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.~~

~~(B) THE COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM GUIDELINES SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE FOLLOWING:~~

- ~~(1) MENTORING;~~
- ~~(2) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING AND SUPPORT; AND~~
- ~~(3) FORMAL ASSESSMENTS OF TEACHERS PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM.~~

~~(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION, INCLUDING:~~

~~(1) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TEACHERS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM; AND~~

~~(2) (4) THE STANDARDS TO DETERMINE WHICH SCHOOLS ARE CONSIDERED HARD-TO-STAFF SCHOOLS.~~

~~(D) (C) FUNDING FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE GUIDELINES REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
