- (8) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE APPROPRIATE SECRETARY ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE; AND
- (9) PERFORM OTHER RELATED ACTIVITIES THAT THE CHILDREN'S CABINET IDENTIFIES.
 - (F) THE COUNCIL SHALL:
- (1) PLAN AND COORDINATE WITH THE LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCILS:
- (I) MULTIPLE UNIT SERVICES TO CHILDREN IN NEED OF RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT; AND
- (II) ENHANCED SERVICES TO CHILDREN WITH INTENSIVE NEEDS, SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH A PLAN DEVELOPED BY THE CHILDREN'S CABINET; AND
- (2) IN COOPERATION WITH THE LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCILS, MONITOR SERVICES PROVIDED TO CHILDREN PLACED IN RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENTS.

4-102.

- (A) THERE IS A LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCIL IN EACH COUNTY.
- (B) EACH LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCIL SHALL INCLUDE:
 - (1) AT LEAST ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM:
 - (I) THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES:
 - (II) THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION:
 - (III) THE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE ADMINISTRATION:
 - (IV) THE LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION:
 - (V) THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT:
 - (VI) THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES;
- (VII) THE LOCAL OFFICE OF THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES:

(VIII) THE LOCAL MANAGEMENT BOARD; AND

- (IX) THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION OR THE LOCAL CORE SERVICE AGENCY, AS DESIGNATED UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 12 OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE; AND
- (2) A PARENT, PARENT ADVOCATE, OR BOTH, APPOINTED BY THE CHAIR OF THE LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCIL IN CONSULTATION WITH THE CHILD ADVOCACY COMMUNITY.
