certain faculty search committee to fill certain faculty vacancies; providing for the composition of the faculty search committee prohibiting more than a certain number of members of the Board of Trustees from being included on certain search committees; altering the amount of money provided by Baltimore City to the College; requiring certain reports; requiring the Board of Trustees and the President to develop and implement an independent system for hearing faculty grievances; requiring a certain system to include the use of a certain independent body that is not affiliated with certain entities to hear certain grievances and make recommendations to the Board of Trustees; requiring the Board of Trustees to adopt certain regulations; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to the governance of Baltimore City Community College.
