SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Education**

16-502.

(b) “Board of Trustees” means the Board of Trustees of Baltimore City Community College.

(c) “College” means Baltimore City Community College, formerly known as the New Community College of Baltimore.

16-505.

(b) (1) The Board of Trustees shall exercise general control [and management of] OVER the College and establish [policies] BROAD POLICY AND LONG-RANGE PLANNING to effect the efficient operation of the College,
