- (a) (1) Except as provided in § 4-409 of this subtitle, this subtitle does not apply to any public improvement made by:

- (a) (1) [Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, the] THE Department shall advise the Board of Public Works and any unit of the State government in connection with any engineering question or matter concerning a public improvement.
