SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 10–301(c) through (n), respectively, of Article – Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 10–301(d) through (o), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

10–301.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, “CHILD” INCLUDES:

- (1) FOSTER CHILD;
- (2) FOSTER GRANDCHILD;
- (3) GRANDCHILD;
- (4) STEPCHILD; AND
- (5) STEPGRANDCHILD.

[(a)] (B) To provide a fund to pay the expense of protecting and managing wildlife, and preventing unauthorized persons from hunting them, a person may not hunt or attempt to hunt during open season and in any permitted manner any game birds and mammals in the State without first having procured either a resident or nonresident hunter’s license. A person may not hunt or attempt to hunt nongame birds and mammals in Baltimore County or Frederick County without first obtaining a license. A permanent resident of a government reservation may obtain a resident hunter’s license.
