- (2) "CORPORATION" MEANS AN ENTITY WITH ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION THAT IS AN APPLICANT FOR OR HAS BEEN GRANTED A LICENSE TO OPERATE A RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM IN THIS STATE
- (3) (I) "LICENSING AGENCY" MEANS THE AGENCY DESIGNATED BY THE COVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LICENSING A RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM.
- (II) "LICENSING AGENCY" INCLUDES THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES.
 - (4) "OFFICE" MEANS THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.
