SOLICITATION, SELECTION, TREATMENT AND PAYMENT OF SUBCONTRACTORS IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT: AND (B) IF REQUESTED, PROVIDE TO THE STATE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE REQUEST A TRUTHFUL AND COMPLETE LIST OF THE NAMES OF ALL SUBCONTRACTORS, VENDORS, AND SUPPLIERS THAT THE COMPANY HAS USED IN THE PAST 5 4 YEARS ON ANY OF ITS CONTRACTS THAT WERE UNDERTAKEN WITHIN THE STATE OF MARYLAND STATE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA, INCLUDING THE TOTAL DOLLAR AMOUNT PAID BY THE CONTRACTOR ON EACH SUBCONTRACT OR SUPPLY CONTRACT. THE COMPANY FURTHER AGREES TO FULLY COOPERATE IN ANY INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED BY THE STATE PURSUANT TO THE STATE'S COMMERCIAL NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY AS SET FORTH UNDER TITLE 19 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, TO PROVIDE ANY DOCUMENTS RELEVANT TO ANY INVESTIGATION THAT IS REQUESTED BY THE STATE, AND TO BE BOUND BY ANY FINAL DECISION ISSUED UNDER THAT POLICY: THE COMPANY UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THAT VIOLATION OF THIS CLAUSE SHALL BE CONSIDERED A MATERIAL BREACH OF THIS AGREEMENT AND MAY RESULT IN CONTRACT TERMINATION, DISQUALIFICATION BY THE STATE FROM PARTICIPATING IN STATE CONTRACTS, AND OTHER SANCTIONS.".

THE REMEDIES PROVIDED BY THIS TITLE ARE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER STATUTORY, LEGAL, OR EQUITABLE REMEDIES THAT MAY BE AVAILABLE AND ARE NOT INTENDED TO BE PREREQUISITE TO OR EXCLUSIVE OF ANY OTHER REMEDIES. 19–118.

THE FILING, INVESTIGATION, HEARING, AND APPEAL OF A COMPLAINT UNDER THIS TITLE MAY NOT HINDER OR AFFECT THE <u>ELIGIBILITY FOR BIDDING</u>, AWARD OF, PERFORMANCE OF, OR PAYMENT ON A CONTRACT PRIOR TO A FINAL <u>ADMINISTRATIVE</u> <u>ADJUDICATED</u> DECISION THAT ESTABLISHES A VIOLATION.
