SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) This subtitle applies only in Garrett County.

- (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the organization is:
 - (1) a bona fide:
 - (i) religious organization;
 - (ii) fraternal organization;
 - (iii) civic organization;
 - (iv) war veterans' organization;
 - (v) hospital;
 - (vi) amateur athletic organization;
 - (vii) patriotic organization;
 - (viii) educational organization; or
 - (ix) charitable organization;
- (2) a county volunteer fire [company] DEPARTMENT or rescue [company] SQUAD; or
- (3) an auxiliary for a county volunteer fire [company] DEPARTMENT or rescue [company] SQUAD.
 - (f) I(1) The holder of a gaming permit may award:
 - I(i) (1) prizes to individuals at a gaming event; and
 - [(ii)](2) only one major prize at each gaming event.
 - (2) During each calendar year, the holder of a gaming event:
- (i) may not conduct or receive the proceeds from more than one gaming event in which the major prize has a value of \$5,000 or more; and
