SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Criminal Law

13–1402.

(a) This subtitle applies only in Garrett County.

13–1403.

(b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the organization is:

(1) a bona fide:

- (i) religious organization;
- (ii) fraternal organization;
- (iii) civic organization;
- (iv) war veterans' organization;
- (v) hospital;
- (vi) amateur athletic organization;
- (vii) patriotic organization;
- (viii) educational organization; or
- (ix) charitable organization;

(2) a county volunteer fire [company] DEPARTMENT or rescue [company] SQUAD; or

(3) an auxiliary for a county volunteer fire [company] DEPARTMENT or rescue [company] SQUAD.

(f) [(1)] The holder of a gaming permit may award:[(i)] (1) prizes to individuals at a gaming event; and[(ii)] (2) only one major prize at each gaming event.[(2)] During each calendar year, the holder of a gaming event:(i) may not conduct or receive the proceeds from more than one gaming event in which the major prize has a value of \$5,000 or more; and
