- (2) authorize each inspector to enter the premises of a licensee to ensure compliance with this section or a rule or regulation adopted under this section.
- (l) The County Commissioners may adopt an ordinance or resolution declaring that:
- (1) a violation of this section or a rule or regulation adopted under this section is [:
  - (1) a civil infraction under Article 25B, § 13C of the Code; or
- (2)] a misdemeanor punishable by a term of imprisonment not exceeding 30 days or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both; AND
  - (2) EACH DAY THAT A VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- (m) After a hearing, if the County Commissioners or a designee of the Board finds that a paper gaming licensee, a wholesale vendor licensee, or an agent of a licensee has violated this section or a rule or regulation adopted under this section, the Board may suspend or revoke the license in addition to any fine or penalty imposed under THIS subsection [(m) of this section].

## 13-1405.

- (a) A person authorized to conduct bingo under subsection (b) of this section shall obtain a bingo permit from the county agency designated by the County Commissioners to issue a bingo permit.
- (b) An organization may conduct bingo for its own benefit or to benefit charity in the county if the organization is a legal resident of the county and is:
  - (1) a bona fide:
    - (i) religious organization;
    - (ii) fraternal organization;
    - (iii) civic organization;
    - (iv) war veterans' organization;
    - (v) hospital;
    - (vi) amateur athletic organization;
    - (vii) patriotic organization;
    - (viii) educational organization; or
    - (ix) charitable organization;
  - (2) a county volunteer[:
    - (i)] fire [company] DEPARTMENT[;] or
    - [(ii)] rescue [company] SQUAD; or
