(c) A person who is not a legal resident of the county may not conduct bingo.

(d) To qualify for a bingo permit, a person shall meet the requirements set by the county.

(e) Only members of [a qualifying] AN organization LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION may conduct and operate bingo games.

~~(f) A person who conducts bingo may not offer or award:~~

- ~~(1) a prize or award with a fair market value exceeding \$5,000; or  
 (2) a money prize exceeding \$5,000.~~

## CHAPTER 298

### (House Bill 133)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Education – Maryland Infants and Toddlers Program – Grants – Funding**

FOR the purpose of ~~repealing a limitation that grants provided under the Maryland Infants and Toddlers Program are subject to the availability of funds in the State budget requiring the Governor to include a certain minimum appropriation in the annual budget for the Maryland Infants and Toddlers Program; repealing certain obsolete provisions of law;~~ correcting an obsolete reference; and generally relating to the funding of the Maryland Infants and Toddlers Program.
