(J) AT THE END OF THE DAY FOR WHICH A CLASS BWTS LICENSE IS VALID, THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL DISPOSE OF UNCONSUMED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES REMAINING IN A CONTAINER OPENED FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions 9-1301.

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (2) (i) "Bond" means a special obligation bond, revenue bond, note, or other similar instrument issued by the county in accordance with this section.
- (ii) "Bond" includes a special obligation bond, revenue bond, note, or similar instrument issued by the revenue authority of Prince George's County.
