(3) INMATE LABOR UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(7) OF THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO INMATES AT THE MINIMUM. PREFELEASE, AND WORK RELEASE SECURITY LEVELS.

- (c) (1) (i) The total State operating fund per full-time equivalent student to the community colleges for each fiscal year as requested by the Governor shall be:
- 1. In [each of] fiscal [years 2003 and 2004] YEAR 2007, not less than an amount equal to [23.1%] 25% of the State's General Fund appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the State as designated by the Commission for the purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article in the previous fiscal year;
- 2. In fiscal year [2005] 2008, not less than an amount equal to [24%] 26% 25.5% of the State's General Fund appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the State as designated by the Commission for the purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article in the previous fiscal year; [and]
