(d) On or before January 1, 2007, the Department shall submit a report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, the Senate Finance Committee, the House Appropriations Committee, and the House Health and Government Operations Committee on the findings and recommendations of the study.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
