Assisted Living Programs - Services Disclosure Statement

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in consultation with ~~certain groups~~ the Maryland Health Care Commission and certain stakeholders, to develop a standard assisted living program services disclosure statement; providing for the purpose of the disclosure statement; requiring an assisted living program to file the disclosure statement with the Office of Health Care Quality; requiring an assisted living program to file an amended disclosure statement with the Office under certain circumstances; requiring an assisted living program to provide a copy of the disclosure statement under certain circumstances; requiring the Department, in coordination with certain groups and individuals, to develop a certain consumer education process; requiring the Department, on or before a certain date, to make a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly; and generally relating to the assisted living program services disclosure statement.
