SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of ~~4 years~~ 1 year and, at the end of May 31, ~~2010~~ 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
