(House Bill 1005)

AN ACT concerning

Workers' Compensation - Civil Defense Volunteers - Emergencies

FOR the purpose of providing that certain civil defense volunteers are covered employees under certain circumstances; designating the State as the employer for these covered employees; repealing certain provisions under workers' compensation law that exclude workers' compensation coverage for certain volunteers from certain counties; requiring volunteers who are covered employees to meet certain qualifications; providing for certain administrative requirements as a condition of receiving workers' compensation benefits; establishing a certain formula for calculating certain benefits; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to covered employment under workers' compensation law.
