3-709. JURY SERVICE.

AN EMPLOYEE HAS THE DUTIES AND RIGHTS SET FORTH:

(1) WITH RESPECT TO JURY SERVICE IN A CIRCUIT COURT OF THIS STATE, IN TITLE 8 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE; AND

(2) WITH RESPECT TO JURY SERVICE IN A FEDERAL COURT, IN 28 U. S. C. § 1861 ET SEQ.

13-218. JURY SERVICE.

THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR EXEMPTION OF A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZED MILITIA FROM STATE JURY SERVICE THAT WOULD UNREASONABLY INTERFERE WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF THE MEMBER'S MILITARY DUTIES OR AFFECT ADVERSELY THE READINESS OF THE ACTIVITY, COMMAND, OR UNIT TO WHICH THE MEMBER IS ASSIGNED.

COMMITTEE NOTE: Ch. 372, Acts of 2006, which enacted revised CJ Title 8, added this section to make the exemption from jury service for militia members more consistent with the exemption for active armed forces members. See revised CJ § 8-306(4).
