this subtitle, provided that the penalty imposed under § 7–266(b)(2)(i) of this article may not exceed [\$250] \$500 per day for any violation of this subtitle.

(b) If an accredited supervisor falsely verifies that work was performed on an affected property pursuant to § 6-819(f) of this subtitle, the owner of the affected property who employs the supervisor and who has actual knowledge of the false verification shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed [\$15,000] \$30,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
