

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Governor work with the National Governors Association to:

(1) relay the concerns of the State to the federal government regarding the amount of federal money available for outreach and assistance on Medicare Part D; and

(2) advocate for additional federal funding and reimbursement for state outreach and education on Medicare Part D, including for federal reimbursement of the funding provided for State outreach and assistance under this Act.

SECTION ~~2~~ 2 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective until the end of ~~September 30, 2006~~ June 30, 2007, and, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 401

(House Bill 1503)
