- (e) Assistance in the repayment of a loan from an entity set forth in § 18-1501(c)(2) of this subtitle shall require the approval of the Office.
- (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EMPLOY NOT MORE THAN ONE STAFF MEMBER TO ADMINISTER THE DEPARTMENT'S PORTION OF THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.

## SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That:

The Department of Education shall conduct a study as to the advisability and feasibility of awarding alternative teaching opportunity grants as tuition assistance grants to individuals who:

- (1) pursue a resident teacher certificate by enrolling in a resident teacher certificate partnership program; or
- (2) take course work at an eligible institution for the purpose of obtaining a teaching certificate while being employed by a county board of education for a paraprofessional position.

SECTION 2- 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
