CHAPTER 439

(Senate Bill 771)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee - Membership, Staffing, and Reimbursement

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to seek recommendations from certain individuals and groups when selecting consumer representatives to the Committee; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to staff the Committee; requiring the chair and staff of the Committee to provide certain information to Committee members at a certain time and in a certain manner; requiring certain members of the Committee to be provided a certain stipend; providing that members of the Committee are entitled to a certain reimbursement; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to provide for a certain dedicated staff person for certain purposes under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

15-103.

- (b) (27) (i) 1. The Department shall establish the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee, composed of no more than 25 members[, the majority of whom are enrollees or enrollee advocates].
- 2. THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE ENROLLEES OR ENROLLEE ADVOCATES.
- 3. AT LEAST FIVE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE ENROLLEES REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ENTIRE MEDICALD POPULATION.
 - (ii) The Committee members shall include:
- 1. [Current] AT LEAST FIVE CURRENT or former enrollees or the parents or guardians of current or former enrollees;
