[(vii)] (VIII) The Secretary shall appoint the [chairman] CHAIR of the Committee.

[(viii)] (IX) The Secretary shall appoint nonvoting members from managed care organizations who may participate in Committee meetings, unless the Committee meets in closed session as provided in § 10-508 of the State Government Article.

- (X) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE COMMITTEE.
- [(ix)] (XI) The Committee shall determine the times and places of its meetings.
- (XII) 1. THE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE AND THE STAFF FOR THE COMMITTEE SHALL PROVIDE THE AGENDA, MINUTES, AND ANY WRITTEN MATERIALS TO BE PRESENTED OR DISCUSSED AT A MEETING TO THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE AT LEAST ± 0.5 DAYS PRIOR TO THE MEETING.
- 2. THE AGENDA, MINUTES, AND WRITTEN MATERIALS SHALL BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE IN A MANNER AND FORMAT THAT IS PREFERRED BY EACH MEMBER AND THAT REASONABLY ACCOMMODATES THE SPECIFIC NEEDS OF THE MEMBER.
- [(x)] (XIII) 1. [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSUBPARAGRAPHS
 SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 2 AND 3 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, a member of the Committee:
 - [1.] A. May not receive compensation; but
- [2.] B. Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- 2. A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE WHO IS AN ENROLLEE SHALL BE PROVIDED A STIPEND FOR THE TIME NEEDED BY THE MEMBER TO PREPARE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MEETINGS.
- 3. A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES FOR DEPENDENT CARE, OVERNICHT ACCOMMODATIONS IF TRAVELING MORE THAN 3 HOURS FROM HOME, PERSONAL CARE, AND COCNITIVE SUPPORTS.
- 2. <u>A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE WHO IS AN ENROLLEE IS</u> ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR:
- A. EXPENSES FOR PERSONAL AND DEPENDENT CARE INCURRED DURING THE MEETING AND DURING TRAVEL TIME TO AND FROM THE MEETING:
- B. EXPENSES FOR COGNITIVE SUPPORTS RELATED TO THE MEETING: AND
- C. APPROPRIATE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE MEETING.
