## 3. ON REQUEST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE FOR A DEDICATED DEPARTMENT STAFF PERSON:

## A. TO REVIEW MEETING MATERIALS WITH ENROLLEE MEMBERS IN ADVANCE OF A MEETING BY TELEPHONE OR IN PERSON: AND

B. TO PROVIDE REFERRALS TO ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006.

## **CHAPTER 440**

(House Bill 1330)

AN ACT concerning

## Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee - Membership, Staffing, and Reimbursement

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to seek recommendations from certain individuals and groups when selecting consumer representatives to the Committee; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to staff the Committee; requiring the chair and staff of the Committee to provide certain information to Committee members at a certain time and in a certain manner; requiring certain members of the Committee to be provided a certain stipend under certain circumstances; providing that members of the Committee are entitled to a certain reimbursement; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to provide for a certain dedicated staff person for certain purposes under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee.
