- (b) (27) (i) 1. The Department shall establish the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee, composed of no more than 25 members [, the majority of whom are enrollees or enrollee advocates].
- 2. THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE ENROLLES OR ENROLLEE ADVOCATES.
- 3. AT LEAST FIVE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE ENROLLEES REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ENTIRE MEDICALD POPULATION.
 - (ii) The Committee members shall include:
- 1. [Current] AT LEAST FIVE CURRENT or former enrollees or the parents or guardians of current or former enrollees;
- 2. **{**Providers**}** NOT-MORE THAN FIVE PROVIDERS who are familiar with the medical needs of low-income population groups, including board-certified physicians;
- 3. Hospital NOT MORE THAN TWO HOSPITAL representatives;
- 4. [Advocates] AT LEAST FIVE BUT NOT MORE THAN 10 ADVOCATES for the Medicaid population, including representatives of special needs populations, SUCH AS:
 - A. CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS:
 - B. INDIVIDUALS WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES;
 - C. INDIVIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES;
 - D. INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL ILLNESS:
 - E. INDIVIDUALS WITH BRAIN INJURIES;
 - F. MEDICAID AND MEDICARE DUAL ELIGIBLES;
- G. INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE HOMELESS OR HAVE EXPERIENCED HOMELESSNESS;
- H. INDIVIDUALS ENROLLED IN HOME– AND COMMUNITY–BASED SERVICES WAIVERS; AND
 - I. ELDERLY INDIVIDUALS;
- J. LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS AND INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING BENEFITS THROUGH THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES PROGRAM; AND
