

(II) NO PART OF THE EARNINGS OF WHICH INURES TO THE BENEFIT OF ANY INDIVIDUAL OR IS USED FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A FACILITY, THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT TO BE USED IN A FACILITY, OR THE EXPANSION OF A FACILITY.

(D) "OFFICE" MEANS THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.

(E) (1) "RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM" MEANS AN ENTITY THAT PROVIDES FOR CHILDREN 24-HOUR PER DAY CARE WITHIN A STRUCTURED SET OF SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES THAT ARE DESIGNED TO ACHIEVE SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES RELATIVE TO THE NEEDS OF THE CHILDREN SERVED AND THAT INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF FOOD, CLOTHING, SHELTER, EDUCATION, SOCIAL SERVICES, HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH, RECREATION, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THESE SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES.

(2) "RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM" INCLUDES A PROGRAM:

(I) LICENSED BY:

1. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;
2. THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES; OR
3. THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES; AND

(II) THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE LICENSING REGULATIONS OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN GOVERNING THE OPERATIONS OF RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS.

(F) "WHOLLY OWNED" INCLUDES LEASED, IF:

(1) (I) THE LEASE IS FOR A MINIMUM TERM OF 15 YEARS FOLLOWING PROJECT COMPLETION; OR

(II) THE LEASE AGREEMENT EXTENDS THE RIGHT OF PURCHASE TO THE LESSEE; AND

(2) THE LESSOR CONSENTS TO THE RECORDING IN THE LAND RECORDS OF THE COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY WHERE THE FACILITY IS LOCATED OF A NOTICE OF THE STATE'S RIGHT OF RECOVERY AS PROVIDED UNDER § 18-706 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(A) THERE IS A RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM.

(B) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS MAY MAKE GRANTS TO COUNTIES, MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS, AND NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR:

(1) THE CONVERSION OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS OR PARTS OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS TO RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS;
