CHAPTER 458

(House Bill 388)

AN ACT concerning

Wage Payments - Prohibition of Printing Social Security Numbers

FOR the purpose of prohibiting ~~an employer~~ certain employers, including certain governmental units, from printing or causing to be printed an employee's Social Security number on a wage payment check or certain other wage payment documents; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to wage payments and Social Security numbers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Labor and Employment

1-101.

(c) "Governmental unit" means:

(1) the State;

(2) a county, municipal corporation, or other political subdivision of the State; or

(3) a unit of the State government or of a political subdivision.

3-502.

(a) (1) Each employer:

(i) shall set regular pay periods; and
