(House Bill 558)

AN ACT concerning

Bay Restoration Fund - Failing Onsite Sewage Disposal Systems - Eligibility for Funds

FOR the purpose of authorizing certain money in the Bay Restoration Fund to be used to provide grants or loans for the cost of repairing or replacing a failing onsite sewage disposal system, with priority given to certain users; altering the priority for certain grants and loans from the Bay Restoration Fund under certain provisions of law; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to eligibility for funds from the Bay Restoration Fund.
