(iv) The Administration modifies a suspension or issues a [restricted] RESTRICTIVE license to the individual under $\frac{\$}{16} = \frac{16}{205.1(n)(2)}$ § 16-205.1(B)(3)(VII) OR (N)(2) [or]. (4), OR (5) OR (4) of this title.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That the Motor Vehicle Administration shall adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this Act.
