- (4) The retiree's allowance will be reinstated on the first day of the month following the month in which the retiree ceased employment with the participating employer.
- (c) A member who retires on or after July 1, 1982, and receives a disability retirement allowance shall provide yearly medical and earnings information on request of the Board of Trustees until the retiree attains normal retirement age.
- (d) If the retiree refuses to provide the information, the Board of Trustees shall suspend the retiree's allowance until the information is provided.
