

(4) The retiree's allowance will be reinstated on the first day of the month following the month in which the retiree ceased employment with the participating employer.

(c) A member who retires on or after July 1, 1982, and receives a disability retirement allowance shall provide yearly medical and earnings information on request of the Board of Trustees until the retiree attains normal retirement age.

(d) If the retiree refuses to provide the information, the Board of Trustees shall suspend the retiree's allowance until the information is provided.
