- (II) FIRST-LINE SUPERVISION OF EMPLOYEES PROVIDING DIRECT SUPPORT OR CARE TO INDIVIDUALS WITH ALCOHOL OR DRUG DEPENDENCY.
- (e) "Program" means the Developmental Disabilities, Mental Health, Child Welfare, and Juvenile Services Workforce Tuition Assistance Program.

- (a) There is a tuition assistance program under this subtitle for use by students at institutions of higher education in the State who:
 - (1) Work as direct service employees in a community-based program; or
- (2) Agree to work as direct service employees in a community-based program in the future.
