7-304.

- (A) A PERSON MAY NOT BUY, SELL, OR OTHERWISE OBTAIN OR DISTRIBUTE THE CALL RECORDS OF A SUBSCRIBER OF CELLULAR TELEPHONE SERVICE, WITHOUT:
 - (1) THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE SUBSCRIBER: OR
 - (2) A COURT ORDER.
- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) <u>"CUSTOMER" MEANS A PERSON WHO SUBSCRIBES TO, OR IS</u> FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR A SUBSCRIPTION TO, TELEPHONE SERVICE FROM A TELEPHONE COMPANY.
- (3) <u>"TELEPHONE" MEANS A DEVICE USED BY A PERSON FOR VOICE</u> COMMUNICATIONS TRANSMITTED IN ANALOG, DATA, OR ANY OTHER FORM.
- (4) <u>"TELEPHONE COMPANY" MEANS A PERSON THAT PROVIDES</u>
 COMMERCIAL TELEPHONE SERVICE TO A CUSTOMER REGARDLESS OF THE
 COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY USED, INCLUDING:
 - (I) TRADITIONAL WIRELINE OR CABLE TELEPHONE SERVICE:
- (II) CELLULAR, BROADBAND PCS, OR OTHER COMMERCIAL MOBILE RADIOTELEPHONE SERVICE:
- (III) MICROWAVE, SATELLITE, OR OTHER TERRESTRIAL TELEPHONE SERVICE; AND
 - (IV) VOICE OVER INTERNET TELEPHONE SERVICE.
- (5) (I) "TELEPHONE RECORD" MEANS INFORMATION RETAINED BY A TELEPHONE COMPANY THAT RELATES TO:
- 1. THE TELEPHONE NUMBER DIALED BY A CUSTOMER OR OTHER PERSON USING THE CUSTOMER'S TELEPHONE:
