(c) (1) "Home health care" means any of the following services that are provided under the general direction of a licensed health professional practicing within the scope of their practice [act]:

- (i) Audiology and speech pathology;
- (ii) Dietary and nutritional services;
- (iii) Drug services;
- (iv) Home health aid;
- (v) Laboratory;
- (vi) Medical social services;
- (vii) Nursing;
- (viii) Occupational therapy;
- (ix) Physical therapy; or
- (x) Provision of medically necessary sickroom equipment and supplies.

(b) The rules and regulations shall provide for the licensing of home health agencies and annual license renewal, and shall establish standards that require as a minimum, that all home health agencies:

(1) Within 10 days of acceptance of a patient for skilled care, make and record all reasonable efforts to contact a physician to obtain the signed order required under [paragraph (2)] ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION;
