(Senate Bill 437)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission - Donor Information - Confidentiality

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission to keep confidential certain information of an individual who makes a donation to the Commission; authorizing the Commission to share certain information about an individual who makes a donation to the Commission with nonprofit or governmental entities under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission and donor information.
