Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 - St. Mary's County - Old Carvers Heights - South Hampton Community Village

FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to extend the deadline by which the Board of Directors of Save the Village must present evidence that a matching fund will be provided; and generally relating to the financing of certain capital projects.

Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of Save the Village, Inc. for the planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of Old Carvers Heights South Hampton Community Village, located in Lexington Park, subject to a requirement that the grantee grant and convey an historic easement to the Maryland
