AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Golf Course License

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to issue a special Class M-G beer, wine and liquor license for use at a certain golf course; specifying that a licensee shall be a golf course manager; providing for an annual license fee; specifying that the license may be used to sell beer, wine, and liquor for consumption only on the land and in the facilities used for golfing purposes; authorizing a golf course manager to designate an agent for certain purposes; authorizing the transfer of a Class M-G license under certain circumstances; requiring the Board of Liquor License Commissioners to adopt certain regulations; exempting Class M-G licenses from a certain restriction; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses issued in Baltimore City.
