AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Workers' Compensation - Students in Unpaid Work-Based Learning Experiences - Waiver

FOR the purpose of authorizing ~~a county board of education~~ the Cecil County Board of Education to waive the requirement that a participating employer reimburse the county for the cost of certain workers' compensation insurance coverage for students placed in an unpaid work-based learning experience; and generally relating to the waiver of workers' compensation reimbursement in connection with unpaid work-based learning experiences.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
