

(2) Of the ~~[11]~~ 13 Board members:

(i) ~~[Five]~~ SIX members shall be licensed nursing home administrators who are practicing actively and have at least 5 years experience as licensed nursing home administrators;

(ii) ~~[Two]~~ THREE shall be individuals who are not nursing home administrators but who are engaged actively in professions that are concerned with the care of chronically ill, infirm, or aged individuals; and

(iii) Four shall be consumer members.

(3) Not more than two members may be officials or full-time employees of this State or of any of its political subdivisions.

(A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT WHO:

(1) IS EMPLOYED AS:

(I) AN ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR IN A HOSPITAL;

(II) A HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATOR;

(III) AN ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR OR A DEPARTMENT HEAD IN A LICENSED NURSING HOME;

(IV) A NURSING HOME ADMINISTRATOR LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE;

(V) A RESIDENT OR INTERN IN A PROGRAM OFFERED BY AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SATISFYING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A BACCALAUREATE OR MASTER'S DEGREE IN HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION;

(VI) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED AN ADMINISTRATOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM IN ANOTHER STATE THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES IS COMPARABLE TO THE ADMINISTRATOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM IN THIS STATE;

(VII) AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF A CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITY;

(VIII) AN ASSISTED LIVING MANAGER;

(IX) A HEALTH CARE RELATED SENIOR MANAGEMENT OFFICIAL;

OR

(X) A NONHEALTH CARE RELATED SENIOR MANAGEMENT OFFICIAL;
