(2) Of the [11] 13 Board members:

- (i) [Five] SIX members shall be licensed nursing home administrators who are practicing actively and have at least 5 years experience as licensed nursing home administrators:
- (ii) [Two] THREE shall be individuals who are not nursing home administrators but who are engaged actively in professions that are concerned with the care of chronically ill, infirm, or aged individuals; and
