

CHAPTER 592**(House Bill 919)**

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Additional Licenses**PG 318-06**

FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum number of Class B (beer and light wine), Class B (beer, wine and liquor), Class BCE (beer, wine, and liquor), and Class BH (beer, wine and liquor) licenses authorized to be issued in Prince George's County; providing that the additional Class B licenses authorized by this Act and issued under State law do not confer off-sale privileges; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

9-217.

(a) This section applies only in Prince George's County.

(b) The number of licenses of each class of alcoholic beverage licenses may not exceed the following maximum amounts:

(6) Beer and light wine license, Class B..... [38] 45

(12) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class B [170] 185

(13) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class BCE..... [3] 8

(15) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class BH..... [20] 25

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an additional Class B license authorized by this Act and issued under Article 2B, § 9-217 of the Code does not confer off-sale privileges.
