(C) ~~A PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT~~

(1) A PERSON MAY NOT SERVE OR DISPENSE SETUPS OR SERVE, DISPENSE, KEEP, OR ALLOW TO BE CONSUMED ON ITS PREMISES ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR OTHER COMPONENT PARTS OF MIXED ALCOHOLIC DRINKS IN A PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT.

(2) A PERSON WHO OPERATES A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT FOR PROFIT THAT IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY NOT KNOWINGLY ALLOW CUSTOMERS TO BRING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION INTO THE ESTABLISHMENT.

(D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.

(House Bill 956)

AN ACT concerning

Insurance - Waiver of Customer Liability - Utility Providers

FOR the purpose of providing that a waiver of customer liability by certain utility providers in a certain agreement between the customer and the utility provider is not considered insurance for purposes of the Insurance Article; and defining certain terms.
