

Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432 of the Acts of 2004

SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the Senate:

- (AM) Kensington Recreation Center. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the County Executive and County Council of Montgomery County for the acquisition, planning, and design of the Kensington Recreation Center, located in Kensington. Notwithstanding Section 13(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real property AND THE GRANTEE MUST PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE PROVIDED BY JUNE 1, 2008 (Montgomery County) 100,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006.

CHAPTER 609
(House Bill 1207)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources - Hunting Wild Waterfowl - Harford and Baltimore Counties

FOR the purpose of altering certain distances that a person must be from shore when hunting wild waterfowl by certain methods in the waters of Harford and Baltimore counties; and generally relating to hunting wild waterfowl in the waters of Harford and Baltimore counties.
