- (B) New Perdue School of Business. Provide funds to prepare preliminary plans to construct the new Perdue School of Business, provided that no State funds may be expended for this project until the private donor submits a letter to the budget committees evidencing the donor's intent to provide a share of the funding for the project. Further provided that the budget committees shall have 45 days to review and comment on the letter 1,700,000

RB30 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE
(Prince George's County)

- (A) Academic Technology Support Center. Provide a portion of the funds to acquire a building for the University of Maryland University College, provided that it is the intent of the General Assembly that the State's commitment of general obligation bond funds and capital PAYGO funds for this project may not exceed 50 percent of the total building acquisition costs to a maximum of \$15,000,000.

Further provided that should any additional State funds be necessary to provide for a 50 percent State match to a maximum of \$15,000,000 for this project, these additional funds shall be provided in fiscal 2008 15,000,000
