# AN ACT concerning

# Rural Maryland Prosperity Investment Fund

FOR the purpose of establishing the Rural Maryland Prosperity Investment Fund as a special fund for certain purposes; providing for the administration of the Fund; providing for the disbursement of money from the Fund in certain proportions and for certain purposes; authorizing the inclusion of certain appropriations in the State budget in certain fiscal years; providing for the award of certain grants from the Fund for certain purposes; requiring a certain annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly; stating findings of the General Assembly; defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Rural Maryland Prosperity Investment Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article - State Finance and Procurement

2-207.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "AGRICULTURE" MEANS THE COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION, STORAGE, PROCESSING, MARKETING, DISTRIBUTION, OR EXPORT OF AN AGRONOMIC, AQUACULTURAL, EQUINE, FLORICULTURAL, HORTICULTURAL, ORNAMENTAL, SILVICULTURAL, OR VITICULTURAL CROP, INCLUDING:
  - (I) FARM PRODUCTS;
  - (II) LIVESTOCK AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS;
  - (III) POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS;
  - (IV) MILK AND DAIRY PRODUCTS:
  - (V) TIMBER AND FOREST PRODUCTS;
  - (VI) FRUIT AND HORTICULTURAL PRODUCTS; AND
  - (VII) SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURAL PRODUCTS.
